

## **CCPRA 2011 Rules**

**Minimum limits in events: 8 entries minimum. up to 12 entries maximum for late entries, only if there is no slack in that event. p.25 #26**

**Ground money will not count towards points. P. 28 #4**

**unless approved by executive board. P.28 #9**

**Riding event stock to be eligible for the Finals and Stock of the Year award, they must be in the draw at a minimum of four outs in current year at CCPRA rodeos for stock of the year and a minimum of two outs for finals eligibility. p.89 #5**

**The judges and flaggers for the Finals will be selected by ballot vote of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors can hire PRCA judges if they feel they are best suited for the Finals. Deadline to apply for judge and flagger position is August 15<sup>th</sup>. The Finals judges will be paid \$800.00 each. P.88.1**

**After arena is ready for next contestant, there shall be no circling of horses in the arena. Fine: \$25 p.74 #23**

**If no one qualifies in the riding events, the money shall be considered ground money to be divided 50% to the stock contractor and 50% to a Bonus money fund to be used in that event at the Finals. This Bonus money will be paid out four monies at the Finals to the average winners. Ground money and Bonus money will not be posted as money won towards points for year end standings. P. 56 . 1**

**CCPRA Executive Board will designate what Finals cattle stock contractor will bring for that year, alternating every other year. If event director does not feel stock is right for the finals he can:**

- a. Give the CCPRA stock contractor a chance to improve cattle.
- b. Go to another CCPRA stock contractor for cattle.
- c. The event director may split cattle from among CCPRA stock contractors to create a finals herd.
- d. The event director may go to an outside source for finals stock if CCPRA stock contractors are not adequate. P.89 .4

**LEGAL CATCH: The only legal catch will be a bell collar catch. Any other catch will be called a "no time". A bell collar catch is defined as the calves whole head with no extremities. P.83.2**

**Possession of alcoholic beverages or drugs within the rodeo arena and behind the chutes. P 32. G**

**PRCA judges that are current on PRCA judge seminars can judge any CCPRA rodeo and must purchase day insurance or CCPRA judges must become a current year member after judging two CCPRA rodeos. If a PRCA or CCPRA judge is not available a responsible CCPRA member may judge ONE rodeo. A judge who is entered in the rodeo in which he judging, may not flag his own event. P. 38 . 17**

**Sanctioned CCPRA Bull Rides and Rough Rider events do not qualify as a rodeo in meeting stock contractor requirements. P 10**

**If round conditions are such that a rerun would be granted, barrel race should be stopped and all contestants in that section granted a rerun when ground conditions are corrected. Each contestant shall have the option to rerun or keep her recorded time. The section will run in the rodeo originally drawn. P. 77**
