Rules and Regulations

- 1) Contestants must conduct themselves in a proper ladylike manner and portray high moral and standards. Contestants will not be permitted to consume alcoholic beverages, smoke, use non-prescription drugs or use foul language at any time during the pageant. Any contestant caught conducting non-ladylike behavior and partaking in disorderly conduct will be disqualified from the pageant.
- 2) All applications shall be postmarked no later than **September 1st**. Any entries postmarked subsequent to the set date will not be accepted. No exceptions shall be made.
- 3) With each application submitted, each contestant will supply the Miss CCPRA Pageant: One 8x10 color and two 5x7 black and white vertical head and shoulder photographs. The 8x10 will be used for judging Miss Photogenic and is suggested to use a plain background. You have the option to send in different poses for each photograph requested. Please no crowns or banners in any of the photographs. All photos become the property of the Miss CCPRA Pageant and will be used for promotional purposes only at the coordinator's discretion.
- 4) Each contestant is required to submit with her application a **Non-Refundable** fee of \$200.00 from private or sponsored funds made payable to the *Miss CCPRA Pageant*. This amount may be exceeded for the opportunity to win the Miss CCPRA High Sponsor custom buckle.
- 5) Each contestant must have a signed Release, Waiver, and Hold Harmless Agreement, a signed Compliance Agreement, a signed Miss CCPRA Statement of Acceptance and a signed Chap and Crown Agreement that will accompany the completed application packet.
- 6) Each contestant shall be given the opportunity to compete for the Miss CCPRA High Sponsor award. This constitutes any amount admitted with the completed application packet that is over the required entry fee. This is optional and in no manner affects the over-all outcome or results of the contest. A complete list of all sponsors with correct name, person to contact, mailing address, phone number, sponsor level, business card and/or any other form of advertisement shall be provided by the contestant and accompany the application packet.
- 7) A judge may not be approached by a contestant, any family member of the contestant's or any individual during the pageant competition. Action of this type will be reported to the Miss CCPRA Coordinator and disqualification of the contestant could result.

- 8) All judges' decisions are final!! The Miss CCPRA Coordinator nor any assistant involved with the pageant has control over points or judges' decisions. If in the event of a tie for any category winner, 1st or 2nd Runner-Up or for Miss CCPRA the final decision will be made by the pageant judges. No points will be added or subtracted from the overall score earned by the contestant.
- 9) In the event of a tie in the horsemanship portion of the competition, the judges will select a third reining pattern at random to determine the winner of the tie breaker. This pattern will be performed by the contestants in question and with their own mount.
- 10) All contestants are expected to arrive promptly at the scheduled time for all pageant activities and must provide their own transportation to and from each event.
- 11) Contestants will be provided horses and tack necessary for the draw horse pattern in the second portion of the horsemanship division. Contestants are expected to provide their own mount for the first portion of the horsemanship division and for each grand entry during the CCPRA Finals.
- 12) In the event that a contestant is selected as Miss CCPRA, 1st or 2nd Runner-Up, she must execute a contract which declares her the winner of the award. Contracts will be provided for signature at the CCPRA Finals, immediately following the coronation unless otherwise prearranged by the coordinator.
- 13) Contestants may not leave the Miss CCPRA Pageant until awards are presented after the coronation ceremony. The pageant is not officially over until after Grand Entry of the second performance of the CCPRA Finals. Until then, all contestants must abide by pageant rules. Failure to comply with this provision could result in a loss of awards, current status of 1st or 2nd Runner-Up and possible future eligibility.
- 14) The contestant crowned as Miss CCPRA is required to be at the CCPRA Finals awards ceremony to present the year end awards to the CCPRA competitors. She will be dressed in a manner reflective of the occasion. This is a ticketed event and only her ticket will be purchased by the Miss CCPRA Pageant. All family members or friends must purchase their own tickets which are available at the rodeo office for the CCPRA Finals.
- 15) The contestant crowned as Miss CCPRA will be required to locate sponsors in a set amount as denoted by the coordinator for the following year's pageant and completed by August 1st of the year of her reign.
- 16) All photographs taken by any personnel or the official photographer of the Miss CCPRA Pageant are considered property of the Miss CCPRA Pageant and may be used for publicity and/or promotional purposes.

Failure to comply with the above rules and regulations may result in disqualification.
